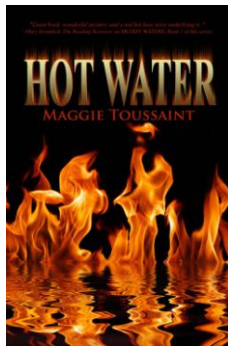




Hey Readers,

While I'm not much of a soil gardener, I've been tending the garden of books. I have a lot of news to share, so please read on!

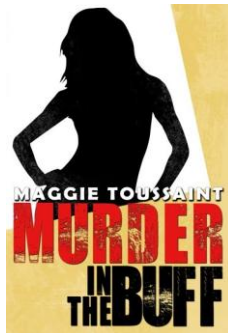

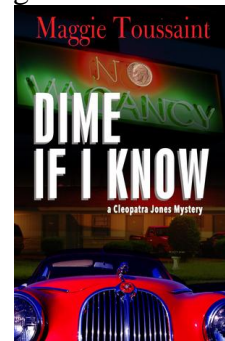
interest, is accused of killing a former girlfriend.
